


Frequently Asked Questions and Information:

Q: What is a County Animal Response Team (CART)?
A: Animal health care professionals and other interested parties and animal lovers working together to help the community prepare for, mitigate (lessen the intensity of), respond to, and recover from, emergencies, disasters, and subsequent animal health issues, by having a group of properly credentialed and trained volunteers and resources available and ready should the need arise.

Q: Who can be a Team member?

A: Anyone over 18 can be a full team member. Special jobs & tasks can be developed for Junior Team members.

Q: What is required to be a Team member?

A: All team members must go online to OKMRC.org and complete a series 4 of online FREE training courses and a background check.

Q: What is a Resource?

A: A Resource is somebody or something or a business that is a source of help or information. A Resource can be a reserve supply of equipment, supplies, persor and/or a location. Examples of a resource are: To of a boarding, grooming and/or training facility, truck and livestock trailer, parcel of land or livestocholding areas or services.

Some Resources are donated while others come at a price which is often reduced.
