

# **Some Open Board Position Descriptions:**

#### **VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR**

- The PCART Volunteer Coordinator works with the Emergency Manager and/or PCART Coordinator (animal agent in charge) in charge to oversee that volunteers for Payne CART are organized, assigned and directed to appropriate locations as needed when needed in a callout situation.
- Will handle day to day and call out Volunteer Coordination and Recruitment of P CART members.
- Will assure that all Volunteers have acquired appropriate credentials.
- Will assist with (if needed) verify assisting veterinarians' credentials after OKMRC volunteer veterinarian resources have been exhausted.

#### **Public Information Officer**

- The PCART Public Information Officer works with Board during day to day operations to contact the media and arrange for coverage of meetings, trainings, and exercise.
- The PIO assists with social media on the FB page and collecting information for posting on the website.
- The PIO helps to create and set-up educational displays at community events.
- In the event of a deployment, the PIO reports directly to the animal agent in charge and the Public Information Officer of the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ), and is the only source of information to the released to the public by animal response team.
